# **International Japanese Camp in Thailand 2018**

Theme: "What is waste? The 3Rs - Let's Work Together!"

The Japan Foundation, New Delhi is happy to announce that the Thai Ministry of Education and the Japan Foundation, Bangkok are inviting students and teachers from all over the world to attend their International Japanese Camp. Please refer to the **Attachment 1** for detailed schedule and pictures from previous years.

The camp will gather around 100 Thai students, 80 international students (including 20 Japanese students), 20 Thai teachers, 22 international teachers, 10-20 teachers (from the host school and organizing committee).

Participating countries: Approximately 30 countries including the 10 ASEAN countries (Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, Philippines, Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Singapore, Brunei), South Korea, China, Australia, India, US, other countries with a Japan Foundation office etc.

From India 5-6 students and 1-2 teachers will be selected. One can apply individually or in a group. **Applications are open now!** Please read the following information, together with the attachments.

## Aim of the program

This program focuses on Project-Based approach: Learning and sharing knowledge using Japanese language as a communication tool

#### For students:

- $\Box$  Develop 21st century skills (such as ability to explore  $\cdot$  ability to guess  $\cdot$  ability to work with others).
- □ Consider how to solve the garbage problem in order to build a better environment.

#### For teachers:

- □ Obtain camping ideas.
- ☐ Form a Japanese-language teacher network crossing national borders.

## 1. Period of the Program

1-5 May, 2018

#### 2. Venue

Royal River Hotel, Bangkok (tentative) (Approximately 1 hour by car from Suvarnabhumi International Airport)

### 3. Eligibility Requirements:

#### For Students:

Eligible to apply for this program are those who

- (1) currently studying Japanese language at high school (between ages of 16 and 18 as of the starting of the program);
- (2) JLPT level N5 or above
- (3) being cooperative
- (4) get consent from their school and legal guardians to participate

#### For Teachers:

- (1) currently teaching Japanese at secondary school
- (2) JLPT level N4 or above
- (3) get consent from their school to participate

## 4. Expenses borne by the organizers

All camp cost includes local transportation within Bangkok (Suvarnabhumi International Airport pick up and drop), accommodation and meals during the camp will be provided by the organizers.

## Expenses borne by the participants

Transportation expenses and other expenses to Bangkok airport.

\* All participants will be required to complete the travel procedure (including Visa application, Round-trip air ticket arrangement and Traveler's insurance).
