
JAPANFOUNDATION S Japanese Language & Culture Course Second Semester [January to May, 2018]

"Elementary level courses are now open"

The JF KOZA is a Japanese language course that uses very distinctive form of teaching material - "MARUGOTO" which conforms to the Japanese language education method called "JF Standard" developed by The Japan Foundation. Our teaching method is quite unique and particular, with more emphasis on brushing up verbal communication than grammatical knowledge. In its concept, the knowledge should not be transferred from the teacher to the students, but **through Notice and Discover activities based on the oral materials, the students are encouraged to acquire Japanese proficiency.** Our course's main purpose is to brush up the teacher's teaching ability and not only for the students. Please note that this course DO NOT conduct JLPT Preparation.

Class8	Those who know about 250 Kanji and can handle simple conversation and has an understanding of the basic	
	grammar patterns.	
Class9	Those who know about 350 Kanji and can handle descriptive conversations about daily life activities.	
	The applicants must have good knowledge of basic grammar patterns.

	*It is mandatory to attach a Passport size photograph on the form. (It must be taken in 6 months)
